

August 28, 2016 call to 911 by Defendant Hernandez immediately following break-in of Premises

DISPATCH: 911, what are you reporting?

TH: Hello?

DISPATCH: Yes; 911, what are you reporting?

TH: Hi. Uh...Someone broke into my house...

DISPATCH: OK. What's your address?

TH: 3601 24<sup>th</sup> Avenue West.

DISPATCH: OK. Do you know when this happened?

**TH: It just happened – I was here, and they were yelling at me? ...and they said that they owned this place...? I just moved in here, like, a week ago? And they said that they...**

**DISPATCH: How did they get in?**

TH: ...that they own it.

**DISPATCH: How did they get in?**

**TH: I – they had a key!**

\*Operator pauses\*

DISPATCH: OK, a male or female?

TH: It was a female, I think- it seemed female.

DISPATCH: OK. Stay on the line. Where did they go?

TH: They just...came in here and they yelled at me and they told me to be outta here and that I needed to leave now...and they brought somebody dressed in a security uniform? They refused to identify themselves...?

2<sup>ND</sup> RADIO DISPATCH: Radio.

DISPATCH: Hello? Oh – okay, radio, this is suspicious. The caller's at 3601 twenty-four Avenue West. She says she just moved in here. A female with a key entered the house and began yelling at her that she owned the house and the caller needed to get out. And then, where did she go, ma'am?

TH: I don't know! I told her I was calling the police and they took off a few...like, less than a minute later.

DISPATCH: Okay. Do you know what they - if they went north, south, east or west, or...?

TH: I have no idea. I was in my apartment. I was half naked, I DIDN'T -

2<sup>nd</sup> RADIO DISPATCH: What apartment number are you in?

TH: I didn't ...I'm in number 304.

Three-OH-four?

TH: I don't know, like- yeah... **I was in no shape to like, I – I didn't even answer the door, yeah, they came in with a key or something. It was locked.**

DISPATCH: Okay. Stay on the phone, okay?

TH: Okay.

DISPATCH: What race was that woman?

TH: She was white. She brought someone in a security outfit that was Hispanic, it looked like.

DISPATCH: Um, like a security person from the apartments?!

TH: No, there's no security here!

DISPATCH: Okay.

TH: I don't know who they were, they were wearing a costume or something.

DISPATCH: Okay. So the woman; white female, about how old is she?

TH: I have no idea how old she is, I dunno –

DISPATCH: Was she 20, 40, 80?

TH: 40, 50?

DISPATCH: Okay. How tall is she?

TH: She looked short.

DISPATCH: What does that mean to you?

TH: They both were like, 5'2" –

DISPATCH: Okay, ma'am, I've already got a call in for you, but I need some specific information, so when you say she was short, how tall do you think that is?

TH: 5'5" or shorter.

DISPATCH: Okay, is she skinny, medium, or heavy?

TH: Heavy.

DISPATCH: What color hair?

TH: She was wearing a hat and it was all stuck up under the hat. The hat said "boss."

DISPATCH: What color is the hat?

TH: Black.

DISPATCH: Like a baseball cap style?

TH: Yes. Yes.

DISPATCH: Okay, what color were her shirt or jacket?

TH: She was wearing black, I think, all black, long sleeves? But I don't remember very clearly, so don't ...

DISPATCH: And do you remember if she was wearing pants or shorts or a skirt?

TH: I think black pants.

DISPATCH: Okay. Alright. And then the guy that was with her, you thought Hispanic?

TH: I think it was a female. I think it was a Hispanic female that was with her.

DISPATCH: Okay. And how old does she look?

TH: She looked younger. 30's. Maybe early 30's. She was wearing a white security shirt, did it say "security" on it?...It had a badge on the sleeves that said "security."

DISPATCH: Okay.

TH: It was button up, I think. She looked like a mall cop or something, or a parking garage attendant.

DISPATCH: Okay, okay. \*Pause\* And are you home alone?

TH: No, my boyfriend is here, and my daughter was in the other room.

DISPATCH: Okay, and what's your name?

TH: My name is Tess.

DISPATCH: And your last name, Tess?

TH: Is Hernandez.

DISPATCH: Alright, and Tess, what's your phone number?

TH: It's (206) 377-9669.

DISPATCH: Okay. And you're sure that the apartments that you're at doesn't have security, and you have...

TH: Yes.

DISPATCH:...no idea who this person is.

TH: I am. This is a condo building, actually, so most people own their own units.

DISPATCH: Okay. Okay. Alright, we've already got a call in for you, we're going to be there just as quickly as we can, and then I just want to double verify there are no weapons involved, right?

TH: Yeah, no weapons.

DISPATCH: And did...did the w-...did the people seem drunk or high, or...?

TH: \*Short pause\* She seemed really, really upset and irate about something and I have no idea why.

DISPATCH: Okay.

TH: I've never seen this person before.

DISPATCH: Okay. We'll be there just as quick as we can, like I said, I've already got a call in for ya, kay?

TH: Okay, thanks.

DISPATCH: Alright, bye.
